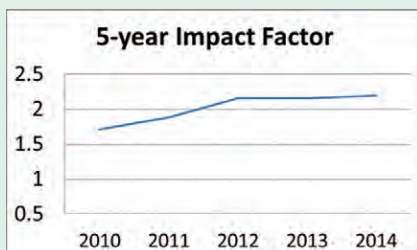
About the Journal

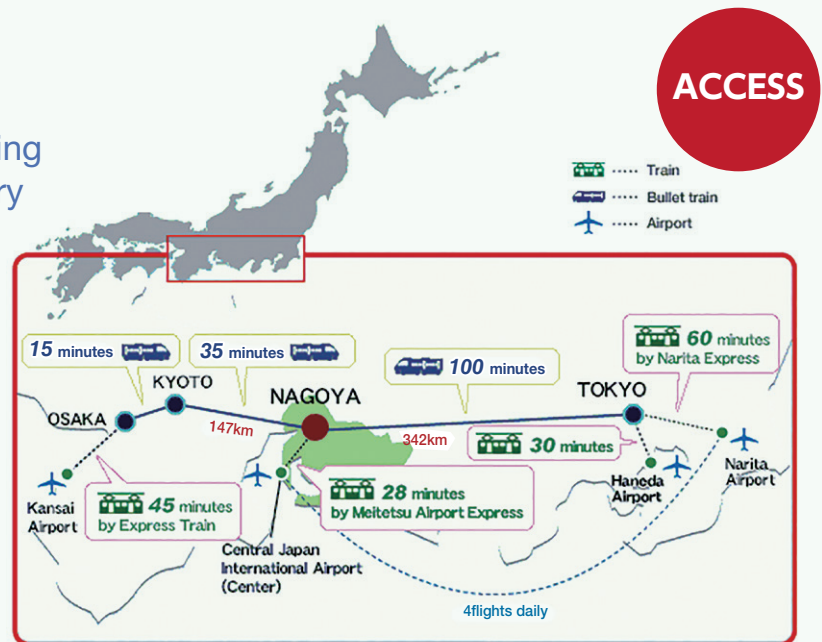

Award

Award recipients will receive:

- Waiver of meeting registration fees.
- Accommodation during the meeting.
- Partial reimbursement of airfare

(JPY70,000 for recipients from World Bank A and B category countries, and JPY 140,000 for those from C and D countries). (Note: World Bank category as of the date of award application.)

Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be psychiatrists not more than 40 years of age or with not more than 10 years experience in psychiatry.
2. Not be previous recipients of the JSPN Fellowship Award.
3. Belong to a World Psychiatric Association member society.

(Note: Up to a maximum of two applicants from each society)
