This exciting opportunity is open to all psychiatric trainees. The trainees are invited to submit an essay of between 3000-5000 words (including references) on the topic of "Forced displacement and mental health: challenges and resilience"

The lucky winner will win a prize of USD \$2000, that will permit them travel to Bangkok and attend the 22<sup>nd</sup> WPA WCP on a subsidised basis.
